

PARTICULARS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF KASHMIR IRRIGATION AND FLOOD CONTROL DEPARTMENT

Particulars of the Organisation:

The Kashmir I&FC Department works under the administrative control of PHE/I&FC Department, Civil Secretariat, J&K Srinagar/Jammu. It is headed by Chief Engineer with its office located at Srinagar. The office address and other contact details are as under:

The Chief engineer is assisted by Technical Officer, Deputy Director (Planning), and Chief Accounts Officer in the Direction Office. In the field an arrangement of circles (06 civil and 01 mechanical circles; headed by Superintending Engineers), Divisions (22 civil and 06 mechanical divisions; headed by Executive Engineers) and Sub-Divisions (102 Nos., each headed by an Assistant Executive Engineer) exists for carrying out the work of the Department. Moreover, Collector Land Acquisition (assisted by 03 Canal Darogas and 14 Zilladars) assists the Chief Engineer in revenue realization and in the matters pertaining to land acquisition.

Functions and Duties:

Kashmir Irrigation and Flood Control Department is entrusted with the job of providing irrigation facility to the farming community in Kashmir Division for *Kharief* and *Rabi* crops, maintaining existing irrigation infrastructure, creating more irrigation potential by conceiving and executing new irrigation projects. The Department is also responsible for implementing flood control measures in river Jhelum, Wullar Lake, and Nallahs in length and breadth of Kashmir valley in order to prevent or reduce the detrimental effects of floods.
