Terms and Conditions:

1. The Bids shall be received on e-procurement portal www.jktenders.gov.in for which bidders shall arrange (DSC) "Digital Signature Certificate" as per Information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online. Bidders should upload scanned copies of cost of documents, EMD & other qualification information as specified in the RFP documents.
2. Bids must be accompanied with the cost of Tender document in the shape of e-challan through Treasury indicating Treasury Voucher No. & date and also indicating the name of work duly crediting to 0701-Rev. Misc uploading a copy of treasury challan /receipt. (The Date of Treasury Challan should be between the date of Start of Bid and Bid Submission End Date).
3. Bid security (Earnest money) in the shape of CDR/FDR/BG Pledged to the Executive Engineer Flood Spill Channel Narbal and original instruments in respect of tender fee (cost of documents), EMD and relevant documents of L1 must be submitted to the Executive Engineer Flood Spill Channel Narbal prior to issuance of allotment in favour of lowest bidder.
4. **Price escalation and Taxes:** - The %age quoted by the bidder shall be deemed to include price escalation and all taxes upto completion of the work. Deduction on account of taxes shall be made from the bills of the contractor on gross amount of the bill as per the rates prevailing at the time of recovery.
5. The firms registered as MSME specifically for providing of 'Consultancy Services in Architectural/Structural/Hydraulic Fields' shall be exempted from paying tender document fee, subject to furnishing of relevant valid certificate for claiming such exemption.

Annexure-A

Eligibility and Qualification Criteria

The following shall be the criteria for qualifying the consultants for the work and therefore relevant documents as sought in the criteria below may be uploaded in technical bid for evaluation purpose:

- 1.** The firm should provide details of working office location as per the format at the end. The firm must have working office within Kashmir valley for being considered to undertake this assignment.

2. Financial Criteria (Average annual Turnover)

The Average Annual financial turnover from consultancy services during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least **Rupees 7.5 Lacs**

Note:- The turn over should be duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

3. Similar Project Experience

Firms should have provided the successful consultancy services for similar projects/works during last 7 years in the field of structural design :

- One project of similar nature costing not less than **10.00 Crores.**
OR
- Two projects of similar nature costing not less than **6.00 Crores.**
OR
- Three project of similar nature costing not less than **5.00 Crores.**

Note: i) Similar projects Experience will mean design of Bridges of span not less than 30mtr, Framed Buildings of 2 storey's or above, OHTs of Capacity more than 1.00 Lac Gallon, Filtration Plants of 2 MGD or above, a hydraulic dam of length more than 30m or any hydraulic structure such as a barrage / weir etc of length more than 30m.

*ii) The Experience Certificate for similar project experience shall be certified by the client to whom the service has been provided not below the rank of Executive Engineer. **Private Experience shall not be considered.***

The firm should have experience and qualified key personnel on board to undertake the task successfully with due diligence:

- iv) In case of MSME firms valid registration which shall be checked online.

Note: If any document is not legible, same shall be the responsibility of the bidder and his bid is liable to rejection.

6. Evaluation of Bids

The technical bids shall be downloaded for undertaking evaluation. The bidders whose technical bids are found substantially responsive shall be listed online. The financial bids of the technically qualified bidders shall be opened only. **The responsive technically qualified bidder with lowest financial cost/price shall be selected.**

Annexure-B

Terms of Reference

1. Background

The site is located 5 Kms away from main Town Sumbal, Bandipora at Village Sultanpora. The proposed work aims to provide a minimum poundage in the Nowgam Jeel for the habitation of the migratory birds and flora & fauna of the water body. At the said village location, the Flood Spill Channel passes through the Nowgam Jheel, which is a wetland and provides shelter to thousands of migratory birds besides a flood basin. The Flood Spill Channel is a 47.4 Km long flood channel which gets activated mostly during the floods and carries the surplus flood waters from river Jehlum to the world famous Wullar lake, preventing the Srinagar city from inundation.

The Irrigation & Flood Control Department is now proposing to construct a flood gate /controlling gate at the exit of the Nowgam Jeel across the Flood Spill Channel u/s Sultanpora Bridge to ensure that a minimum water level is maintained in the jheel for its bio-diverse life and provide safe shelters to the migratory birds during the lean discharge season.

2. Scope of Work

The consultants will have to work closely with the officers of FSC Division Narbal. The scope of the work covers but not limited to the following:

- i) Ground Reconnaissance Survey to study topographical and site features, assessment of the selected alignment of the gate and other appropriate detail which the consultant deems necessary.
- ii) Topographic survey to capture the essential ground features along the alignment which may include contour mapping etc.
- iii) Sufficient longitudinal section and cross-sections at intervals not more than 50 mts and site plan using total station/Auto level or any other sophisticated instrument to work out proposals.
- iv) Sub-soil exploration and Geotechnical investigation with at least three number bore holes at the site up to at least 25 mts depth. Retrieving of necessary soil samples for testing as per relevant IS codes and preparation of soil investigation report.
- v) Preparation of General Arrangement Drawing (GAD) for the proposed structures for approval of client.

- vi) Detailed Structural & Hydraulic Design including the electro-mechanical component of the design and Preparation of Good for Construction (GFC) Drawings for execution of the project.
- vii) Preparation of complete Detailed Estimates as per the design requirements as per JK-SOR 2022 and BOQ for the work.
- viii) Construction of Sequence activity / bar charts for optimization of the work supported with drawings for successful implementation of work.
- ix) Laying out plan and setting out the control points at the time of start of execution of the work.
- x) Vetting of the design and drawings by the DIQC Srinagar and approval thereof.
- xi) Mandatory site visits during execution of the work to the site as per requirement.
- xii) Provide work plan / execution plan for the execution of the work for the diversion of the flow without affecting the irrigation & drinking water supplies D/S the site during the execution and construction of gate.

3. Proof checking

The consultant shall be responsible for getting the design proof checked and vetted from Design Inspection and Quality Control Department, Gogjibagh Srinagar. The charges for proof checking shall be borne by the consultant and same shall be deemed to be included in his price bid. The changes/modification/revisions suggested by the vetting authority shall be done promptly by the consultant so that vetting is expedited. He may have to do regular follow up for the same until design is vetted for which he must ensure proper liasoning without delay.

4. Time Schedule

The entire assignment as per the scope of work has to be completed within 30 days.

5. Report and Documents to be submitted by Consultant

The Consultant shall submit to the client the following report and document after completion of each stage of work and in the number of copies indicated against each:

6. Payment Schedule

The mode of payments to be made in consideration of the work to be performed by the consultants shall be as follows. No payment shall become eligible for the next stage till the consultant completes to the satisfaction of the client the work pertaining to the preceding stage.

7. Taxes

The financial offer of the consultant is deemed to include all taxes, GST, Income tax as applicable to the consultancy service payments and same shall be deducted as per rules in vogue from the running payments of the consultant.

8. Data and Services by Client

The client shall provide necessary cooperation to the consultant in undertaking the assignment. The site will be identified by the client to start the work on ground. The discharge & HFL at the proposed gate site of the Flood Spill Channel shall also be provided.

9. Responsibility of Consultant

The Consultant shall be responsible for accuracy of the data collected by him directly or procured from other agencies/authorities, the designs, drawings, estimates and all other details prepared by him as part of these services. He shall indemnify the client against any inaccuracy in the work which might surface during implementation of the project. The Consultant will also be responsible for correcting at his own cost and risk, the drawings including any re-survey/investigations and correcting layout etc. if required during the execution of the work.

The consultant shall indemnify the client against any inaccuracy/ deficiency in the designs and drawings of the proposed structure and the client shall bear no responsibility for the accuracy of the design and drawings submitted by the consultants.

The survey control points established by the consultant shall be protected by the consultants till the completion of the services and handed over for future use of the client.

10. Release of EMD/Bid Security

The EMD/Bid Security shall be released in favour of the consultant after successful completion of services including consultant visits during the execution of the work to the best satisfaction of the client. In case the consultant does not complete the assignment as per the agreed terms and conditions, his/her EMD is liable to be forfeited. In case any deficiency arises in the services offered under this contract, the client shall take appropriate action including the forfeiture of the EMD. **The consultant should exercise due diligence and standard professional ethics while delivering the services. Any misleading, inaccurate and deficient document/detail/advice shall attract action including forfeiture of the EMD.**

11. Penalty for Delay

The assignment under this contract is time bound and to be completed without delay and spilling over. In case consultant does not take steps to complete the task within the stipulated time, he will be penalized for such delays beyond the completion time. The amount will be recovered from his due payments as per discretion of client.

12. Termination of Contract

The contract is liable to be terminated by the Client in case:

- i) Consultant fails to discharge its obligations under the contract,
- ii) Consultant fails to comply with the notices and instructions of client.

13. Jurisdiction

The Contract has been entered into at Narbal- Budgam and its validity, construction, interpretation & legal effects shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the court of Budgam. No other jurisdiction shall be applicable.
