## OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Tenders must be accompanied with cost of tender document in the shape of Treasury Challan/receipt in favour of Executive Engineer, Jal-Shakti (I&FC) Division Sopore.
  2. The Tenders for the works shall remain **valid for a period of 90 (Ninety) days** from the date of opening of Tenders.
  3. The Tenders shall be deposited in electronic format on the departmental website [www.jktenders.gov.in](http://www.jktenders.gov.in)
  4. The Tender uploaded on the website up to due date and time will be opened on the schedule date and time or any other date convenient to the tender opening authority.
  5. The tenderer shall have to execute the agreement within 10-days after fixation of contract.
  6. **Instruction to Tenderer regarding E-Tendering process:-**
    - a) Tenderers are advised to download Tender submission manual from the “downloads” option as well as from “Tenderers manual Kit” on website [www.jktenders.gov.in](http://www.jktenders.gov.in) acquaint Tenders submission process.
    - b) To participate in tendering process Tenders have to get digital signature certificate (DSC) as per information technology act. 2000 Tenderers can get digital certificate from approved vendor.
    - c) The Tenderer have to submit their Tenders online in electronic format with digital signature. No financial Tender will be accepted in physical form.
    - d) Tender will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned above.
    - e) Tenderers must ensure to upload scanned copy of all necessary documents like P.W.D. Registration Card duly renewed, Verification of Registration Card, Call Deposit Receipt, PAN, G. S. Tin, Latest GST Return (Latest GST Quarter/Month) **(S.no./Name of the work must be written on Treasury challan and S.no./NIT no. must be written on CDR)/receipt under MH 0702** in respect of Irrigation & Flood Control Works, in respect of each work as mentioned in the NIT in addition to other formalities in vogue. **(any failure will lead to cancellation of bid).**
- Note: - Scan all documents on 100dpi with black and white options.**
7. **No Provisional Certificate in respect of GS Tin Registration Certificate shall be accepted henceforth. Besides all the bidders are requested to upload valid (Regular GS Tin Registration Certificate).**
  8. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reason.
  9. **The Departmental material (TMT Steel Bars) available in Divisional Store shall be supplied to the contractor on the prevalent stock issue rates. However, the contractor shall be authorized to purchase rest of the material viz. cement and steel of approved brand and manufacture conforming to relevant BIS/IS Codes as per set codal procedure/ rules.**
  10. Scanned copy of cost of tender document in shape of Treasury Challan under MH 0702 in respect of Irrigation and Flood Control Division Sopore Works and Earnest Money Deposit/ Tender security in **shape Call for Deposit Receipt @2%** pledged to Executive Engineer I&FC Division Sopore must be uploaded with the Tender
  11. The date of start of the work shall be reckoned within one week from the date of issuance of L.O.I./Contract allotment as the case may be.
  12. **Penalty for delay in completion:** - In case of delay in completion of work beyond stipulated period of completion, penalty up to maximum of 10% of the contract shall be imposed.
  13. **Time extension:-**Suitable time extension shall be granted in case of increase in scope of Work and in the event of delay beyond control of contractor to be determined by the department.
  14. **Advance Payments:-** No mobilization advance/equipment advance shall be paid.
  15. **Retention Money:-** 10% shall be deducted from each running bill of the successful contractor which shall be released after virtual completion of work in all respects.
  16. The tender receiving authority reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
  17. **Traffic regulations:-** The contractor is bound to adhere to traffic regulations as is applicable from time to time and ensure arrangements of smooth regulation of traffic during execution of work.
  18. **Arbitration:-** The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the arbitration procedure Stated in the J&K conciliation and arbitration Act No. xxxv of 1997 issued vide SRO No. 403 vide notification of J&K Govt. “Law Department” 11<sup>th</sup> December-1997).
  19. **Defect Liability period.** The DLP shall be calculated from date of certified completion of work and period shall be 06-months/one working season.
  20. **Safety:** - The contractor shall be responsible for safety of all activities at site of work.
  21. **Discoveries:-** Anything of historical or other interest or of significant value Un expectedly discovered on the site shall be the property of the government.
  22. **After peer review of the design, certain changes were effected in pile dia, length and reinforcement due to which target protection length shall be now 81 mtrs instead of 110 mtrs.**
  23. **Tests:** - The contractor shall be solely responsible for carrying out the Mix design of M 35 from design consultancy vetted by reputed consultant/NIT/DIQC also the mandatory tests required for the quality

control shall be done by his own costs and will submit the test reports from time to time to the Concerned Asst. Ex. Engineer as well.

24. **The outcome of the pile test report shall decide the further viability of the conceived design at this stage. In the event any modifications are required, the same shall be done by the concerned Ex. Engineer along with vetting from reputed consultant/NIT/DIQC.**
25. **Termination:** - The department may terminate the contract if the contractor causes a fundamental breach of the contract.
26. **Fundamental breach of contract will include:** -
- Continuous stoppage of Work for a period of 30 days without authorization of Engineer in-charge.
  - Pursuant to the process of termination of defaulted contract, the department reserves the right to invite fresh tender for the balance work at the risk and cost of defaults' contractor/agency.
  - If In case contractor fails to start /complete the work, within the stipulated time period, his name / firm shall be blacklisted.

28. **Specification/Quality Control:** - All items of works shall conform to Specifications as per IRC/MORTH/NBO/CPWD/SSR/ Any other prescribed specifications.
29. **Insurance:** - Insurance cover to Labour / Machinery / Work / Plant material / Equipment by the contractor shall be mandatory.
30. **Laws Governing the Contract:-**The contract shall be governed by Laws of the land.
31. **Court's Jurisdiction:-**In case of any disputes/differences between contractor and Department the jurisdiction shall be J&K UT.
32. **Time extension:-**
- The work is to be completed within the limit specified in the NIT and the time of completion will also increase/decrease in proportion with additional/deleted quantum of work depending upon the actual quantum of work.
  - Request for extension of time shall be made by the contractor in writing not later than fifteen days of happening of the event causing delay. The contractor shall also indicate in such a request the period for which extension is desire.
  - Abnormal/ bad weather or serious loss or damage by fire or civil commotion, strike or lockout (other than among the labour engaged by the contractor) affecting any or the trades employed on the work' or non-availability of departmental stores. Any other cause which in the absolute discretion of the accepting authority is beyond the contractor's desired.
  - Extension of time shall be also admissible in the event of temporary suspension of work.
33. The tender/bid is liable to rejection if it does not full fill the requirements as laid down in NIT.
34. All other terms, conditions are as per the PWD form 25 (Double agreement form) /Master NIT.
35. The L-1 contractor shall have to furnish the **performance security@3%** in shape of **CDR/FDR pledged to Executive Engineer I&FC Division Sopore** of the value of contract valid till DLP before issuance of LOA / LOI. In case of L-1 failing to provide performance security @3% for the works within 7 days after being notified, his bid shall be cancelled and **work shall be executed through other sources U/R at the risk, cost and responsibility of L1.**
36. **In case of abnormally low bids greater than 30% below, the L1 has to submit the detailed price analysis as per 5.6.4 rule of Manual for procurement of works 2019, within two days failing which it will be deemed that the bidder is not serious and tender will be floated afresh and he/she will be debarred from participating in tendering as per rules. Besides, the CDR will be forfeited which may be noted.**
