- 1):- **The Bidders are advised to read all conditions laid down in the NIT carefully before uploaded softcopy any short fall if any found in the soft copy the tender shall be rejected**
- 2) **As per Circular issued by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Sectt. Finance department vide No.OM No.A/24(2017)-651 dtd. 07-06-2018 which reads as under :-**
 - a) **Furnishing of Hard Copies of bids immediately after submission of E-tenders is dispensed with. The same should be obtained only from the Bidder who's declared 1st Lowest (L-1) after opening of financial bids .**

1. The Bid shall be accompanied by a non-refundable Tender Document Fee, to be deposited online in favour of the Chief Engineer, Kashmir Irrigation & Flood Control Department, through the following bank account:

The Bid shall also be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/Bid Security to be deposited in favour of the Chief Engineer, Kashmir Irrigation & Flood Control through the bank account mentioned above.

The Bid, complete in all respects and accompanied by documentary proof of payment of the Tender Document Fee and EMD/Bid Security, shall be uploaded on the e-tendering portal www.jktenders.gov.in on or before the prescribed date and time for submission of bids. . The Authority will not be responsible for any delay in submission of bid due to any reason whatsoever.

1. Unbalanced Bid: In case the bid is found to be unbalanced, the successful bidder (L1) shall have to deposit an **Additional Performance Security** in accordance with the Govt. of **J&K-Finance Department Circular No:FD-Code/441/2021-02-158, Dated: 08/08/2025,as tabulated** below:

1	Up to 10% below	Nil.

Note: The Additional Performance Security shall be treated as a part of Performance Security.

2. The date and time of opening of Bids shall be notified on Web site www.jktenders.gov.in and conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The bids of responsive bidders shall be opened online on same Web Site in the office of Executive Engineer Flood Spill Channel Division Narbal.
 3. The bids for the work shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids.
 4. The normal deposits to be deducted as per GFR 2017 rules from running bills to be released after DLP of the work is over.
 5. The tender opening authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders or any part of any tender without assigning reason thereof.
 6. **Defect liability period of the work shall be commencing six months after completion of work.**
 7. **Instruction to bidders regarding e-tendering process.**
Bidders are advised to download bid submission manual from the "Downloads" option as well as from "Bidders Manual Kit" on website www.jktenders.gov.in to acquaint bid submission process.
To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get 'Digital Signature Certificate (DSC)' as per Information Technology Act-2000. Bidders can get digital certificate from any approved vendor.
The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with digital Signature. No financial bid will be accepted in physical form.
Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned in Para-1.
- 7.5. Bidders must ensure to upload scanned copy of all necessary documents with the bid.
- Note: - **Scan all the documents on 100 dpi with black and white option.**
8. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reasons.
 9. Bidders are advised not to make any change in BOQ (Bill of Quantities) contents. The BOQ downloaded should be inclusive of all taxes.
 10. Bidders should note that if the documents uploaded/submitted on the basis of which the contract has been awarded are found fake/ not genuine at any time, the contract shall be cancelled and the contractor/ bidder shall be blacklisted for participation in this division for a period of **One year** besides the performance security deposited for the said work shall be forfeited.
 11. **Price escalation and Taxes:-** The %age quoted by the bidder shall be deemed to include price escalation and all taxes upto completion of the work. Deduction on account of taxes shall be made from the bills of the contractor on gross amount of the bill as per the rates prevailing at the time of recovery.
 12. Bidders are advised to use "My Documents" area in their user on www.jktenders.gov.in e-Tendering portal to store such documents as are required.
 13. **Instruction to Bidder (ITB)**
The Bidder must have to upload (soft copies) of the following documents (Photostat/Original should be clearly seen in all respect with Ink Signed and Seal):-
 - **The bidder shall upload, along with the bid, documentary evidence in support of Tender Document Fee and EMD/Bid Security, such as transaction receipts, payment acknowledgements, or bank-generated payment confirmations. Failure to upload such documentary proof shall render the bid liable to be treated as non-responsive.**
 - **Registration Card valid & renewed for the year in which bids are invited.**
 - **Valid GSTIN Registration Certificate.**
 - **PAN Card With No.**
 - **Bidder shall furnish proof of latest returns (i.e. latest clearance certificate) in form of:-**

- GSTR-I of the latest quarter / latest month whichever is applicable to the bidder.
 - GSTR-3B of the latest quarter / latest month whichever is applicable to the bidder.
 - (Note:- The GSTR-I/GSTR-3B Confirmation status will be checked online. if GSTR-I/GSTR-3B found invalid. The Card will be Barred for further tendering Process in the concerned Division)
 - Every participating supplier/contractor to mandatorily disclose the bank account number which is linked with their GSTIN at the time of bid submission. No payments shall be released to any other bank account except the one linked with the GST registered number of the successful bidder.
 - Other Relevent Documents accordingly NIT.
 - The lowest Tender will have to submit hard copies of all documents uploaded on e-tending portal before issuance of LOI or Allotment.
14. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reasons.
 15. The contractor shall have to pay necessary royalty charges to Geology & Mining Department for the item of "Supply of stones/boulders and supply of earth from Karevas" of its own. Nothing shall be paid by the Department.
 16. The bidder at his own responsibility and risk should visit and examine the site of the work and its surroundings before submission of bid.
 17. **1%(One percent)** Labour Cess shall be deducted at the time of payment.
 18. The work should be executed within the time limit as stipulated in the NIT.
 19. No variation of quantity or rates is admissible.
 20. In case if the contractor fails to execute the work as per condition and time limit prescribed in the NIT. The work shall be put to fresh tenders at his risk and cost, besides debarring from participation in tendering process. In addition to imposition of penalty as warranted under rules.
 21. The Service Tax will be deducted from the gross amount as per the rates in vogue at the time of payment.
- General Conditions of Contract:-**
22. The date of start of the work shall be reckoned within three days from the date of issuance of LOI/Contract allotment as the case may be.
 23. Drawl of agreement with this department on PWD form-25 Double within 3 days after fixation of contract.
 24. **Penalty for delay in completion:-**In case of delay in completion of work beyond stipulated period of completion, penalty upto maximum of 10% of the contract shall be imposed.
 25. **Royalty Clearance:** The contractor shall be required to obtain the Royalty Clearance Certificate from the Department of Geology & Mining in respect of the minor minerals such as RBM, Nallah muck, boulders, aggregates, sand, clay, nallah bajri, quarry-stones etc, as applicable to the work. In the absence of said certificate, no payment shall be released to the contractor
 26. **Advance Payments:-** No Mobilization /Equipment Advance shall be paid .
 27. **Secured Advance:-** No Secured Advance is admissible / Payable.
 28. **Schedule of payment:-** The payment schedule shall be fixed after award of contract in favour of successful bidder, on the basis of availability of funds and value of work executed, shall be determined by the Engineer.
 29. **Amendment of bidding document:-** Before the deadline for submission of bids the employer may modify the bidding documents by issuing Addenda.
 30. **Restoration of work:-** On completion of contract the contractor shall be responsible to remove all un-used material and restore all work in its original position at his own cost.
 - a. **Arbitration:-** The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the arbitration procedure stated in the J&K conciliation and Arbitration Act No:-xxxv of 1997 issued vide SRO No:-403 vide Notification of J&K Govt., "Law Department" 11th

December-1997.

- b. **Safety:-** The contractor shall be responsible for safety of all activities at site of work.
- c. **Discoveries:-** Anything of historical or other interest or of significant value unexpectedly discovered on the site shall be the property of the Govt.
- d. **Tests:-**The contractor shall be solely responsible for carrying out the mandatory tests required for the quality control at his own cost.
- e. **Termination:-** The employer may terminate the contract if the contractor causes a fundamental breach of the contract.
- f. The date of start of work shall be reckoned within three days from the date of issuance of allotment/ Letter of intent. In case the agency fails to execute the work, the deposits in the shape of performance Security shall be liable for forfeiture besides the Contractor will be suspended for participation in the tendering process in this department for a period of one year from the bid due date of this work without serving any notice.
- g. **ALL KEY CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL shall have to be strictly as per prescribed specifications and approval of the Engineer In-charge.**
- h. Satisfactory maintenance for such period.
- i. Failure on part of the contractor to fulfill his obligations of maintenance schedules shall result in forfeiture of the Performance Security deposits held for this purpose for this work.
- j. **Fundamental breach of contract will include.**
 - i. Continuous stoppage of Work for a period of 30 days without authorization of Engineer in- charge.
 - ii. Contractor is declared bankrupt.
 - iii. Any evidence of involvement of contractor in corrupt practices.
 - iv. If the contractor indulges in willful disregard of the quality control measures put in place by the department.
 - v. Contractor delays the completion of work beyond stipulated time of completion.
 - vi. Pursuant to the process of termination of defaulted contract, the employer reserves the right to invite fresh tender for the balance work at the risk and cost of defaulter contractor.
 - vii. Major Labour Laws applicable to establishment engaged in building and other construction work:-
 - a) Workmen compensation act 1923.
 - b) Payment of Gratuity Act 1972.

31. Laws Governing the Contract:-The contract shall be governed by Laws of the land.

- 32. Insurance:-** Insurance cover to Labour / Machinery / Work / Plant material / Equipment by the contractor shall be mandatory.
- 33. Courts Jurisdiction:-**In case of any disputes/differences between contractor and Department the jurisdiction shall be J&K State.
- 34. Time Extension**
- a. The work is to be completed within the time limit specified in the NIT and the time of completion will also increase/decrease in proportion with additional/ deleted quantum of work depending upon the actual quantum of work.
 - b. Requested for extension of time shall be made by the contractor in writing not later than fifteen days of happening of the event causing delay. The contractor shall also indicate in such a requested the period for which extension is desired.
 - c. Abnormal/bad weather of serious loss of damage by fire of Civil commotion, strike or lockout (other than among the labour engaged) affecting any or the trades employed on the work, or non availability of departmental stores. Any other cause which in the absolute discretion of the accepting authority is beyond the contractor's desire.
 - d. On contractor's representation based on the grounds as detailed above the time for completion of the work may be extended by a period considered reasonable by the Department.
 - e. Extension of time shall be also admissible in the event of temporary suspension of work.
- 35.** The tender/bid is liable to rejection if it does not fulfill the requirements as laid down in NIT.
- 36.** All other terms and conditions same as laid down in the GFR Manual for Procurement of works 2022 with upto date amendments, PWD Form-25 Double shall also remain in force.
